

Cumbria Schools Orienteering Association

Constitution

1. Cumbria Schools Orienteering Association (CSOA) is part of the Cumbria Sport association.
2. The object of CSOA is to promote the sport of orienteering to pupils within schools in Cumbria.
3. CSOA will hold annual Cumbria Schools Orienteering Championships. The Championships will be organised by the orienteering clubs in Cumbria - LOC, WCOC and BL.
4. The committee will be made up of the officers of CSOA (Chairman, Secretary and Treasurer) plus committee members from schools and helpers in Cumbria (a minimum of 3).
5. (a) All schools in Cumbria are entitled to apply for grants to help their juniors to get to events and towards the costs of training and tours.

(b) All pupils at schools in Cumbria are entitled to apply for grants towards the costs of orienteering training and tours.

(c) Orienteering Clubs in Cumbria are entitled to apply for grants towards the costs of providing training and events for pupils in Cumbrian schools.
6. In the event of the dissolution of CSOA, any funds will be distributed to organisations sharing similar objectives to CSOA.
7. Accounts will be audited annually and the Treasurer will present a report to the AGM.
8. The BOF policy for the protection of young and vulnerable people has been adopted by CSOA, and can be viewed on the BOF website.
9. The BOF code of conduct for club officials and volunteers has been adopted by CSOA, and can be viewed on the BOF website.
10. The BOF Equity Policy has been adopted by CSOA, and can be viewed on the BOF website.
11. Alterations to the constitution should only be made at the AGM of CSOA.
